This was followed by Dr. Lingeswar MDS (prosthodontics) the guest speaker forthis PCC who gave a detailed lecture on primary impression and tentative bite.



The participants had a brief 15 min tea & snacks break Dr. Lingeswar proceeded to the clinics for the chairside demo of the primary impression and tentative centric bite on the patient which was telecast to the lecture hall where Dr.Prakash explained the steps to the audience who had optedfor the lecture option only (mainly undergraduates).



At 12:00 the representatives of the IDAGV and 41st AP State Conference arrived and recognized the speakers in the presence of the Vice Principal Dr.Anil Chirla.

Dr. Lingeswar continued with a lecture on the secondary impression and intra oral tracing procedure at the lecture hall followed by the chair side demo on secondary impression, jaw relations, tracing and bite registration. Once again Dr. Prakash explained the process being telecast to the audience at the lecture hall.



This was followed by the lunch.


Post lunch there was a session of case discussions.















